

LEXINGTON RE-ENACTMENT 2008

Participant Guidelines – Women & Children

- Must attend rehearsal April 6th @ 2PM Lexington Green
(Rain date Sunday April 13th @2PM)
- Must be appropriately dressed in Colonials
- Black shoes (no sneakers) required for all children and adults
- Assignments to be given out at re-enactment rehearsal
- All children participants must be those of members only, any exceptions must be approved by the re-enactment committee
- Children must be accompanied by parent or guardian

- **When to go on/off the field during re-enactment**

- When the drums for recall stop and Brits line up **Run On** field to administer to love ones
- After Brits line up and fire a salute **Run Off** the field
- After Brits march off the green **Run On** to administer to love ones

- Women to kneel at dead and wounded and console them, walk off field toward pine tree with wounded & dead.
- Name tags for all young children

Patriot's Day Morning

- All Women & Children must sign in Patriot's Day morning with Henry Murphy at St Brigid's Kennedy Hall @ 4:30 AM
- We will walk to Green as a group at 5:00 AM and meet at the Rock
- Pickup spot (or meeting place) will be at the Rock
- As the Regulars march off the Green, the narrator begins
- Walk off with all dead and wounded. At this time its OK to invite your family and friends onto Green for picture taking.
- The Minutemen will eventually line up and head off to 'The Old Burial Ground'
- Women and children will assemble between Minutemen and firing group for *safety*
- Then to St. B's (Kennedy Hall)for the morning parade
(Please note that all women & children are invited to participate)
- Lanterns are encouraged
